- Can I publish the paper in another journal if I sign the Licence to Publish Proceedings Papers?

Answer: According to the copyright of the licence, when reproducing the contribution or extracts from the paper published in the proceeding, the Author will acknowledge and reference first publication in the Volume of the proceeding. It should be noted that acceptance of the paper is decided by the journal that you submit.

- Is the proceeding EI and Scopus indexed?
